Regarding Accommodations:

There are no hotels in Lansdowne, but there is one B&B that appears to be open in April; it gets good reviews on trip advisor. It's called the B&B Tekdiv, and it's quite close to Lansdowne. It will come up on a search of trip advisor or [booking.com](https://www.booking.com), using 1000 Islands as the location.

There are lots of places to stay in either Gananoque or Brockville; the 2 towns are almost the same distance from Lansdowne.

Robin typically stays in Gananoque, west of Lansdowne. It's a nice tourist town with many reasonable hotels and some stately-looking B&Bs. I have no informed suggestions to make, but the [booking.com](https://www.booking.com) search results would be the best place to start.

Anyone coming from east of the 1000 Islands may also be interested in Brockville. Again, I have no informed suggestions, but these 3 hotels are very conveniently located, just off the 401. See [booking.com](https://www.booking.com) for Holiday inn Express, Comfort Inn, or Travelodge.
